


CALIFORNIA TAHOE CONSERVANCY

PROPOSITION 1 GRANT ANNOUNCEMENT



Application Deadline: October 9, 2015

The California Tahoe Conservancy announces the availability of funding through its Proposition 1 Grant Program. The *Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014* allocated funding to the Conservancy for a competitive grants program supporting multi-benefit ecosystem and watershed protection and restoration projects.

FUNDING AVAILABLE: Up to \$14 million

TYPES OF GRANTS: Planning, Implementation, Acquisition, and Monitoring

TYPES OF PROJECTS: Multi-benefit Stormwater Quality, Ecosystem and Watershed Management, Aquatic Invasive Species, Forest Health, and/or Sustainable Communities projects.
