California Tahoe Conservancy

GRIFF CREEK CORRIDOR AND PUBLIC ACCESS PROJECT

Staff recommends that the California Tahoe Conservancy (Conservancy) make the following findings based on the accompanying staff report pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.:

“The Conservancy, in its role as a responsible agency under the California Environmental Quality Act, has reviewed and considered the Griff Creek Corridor and Public Access Project (Project) Initial Study and Negative Declaration (IS/ND) certified by Placer County on December 6, 2016.

The Conservancy finds, on the basis of the whole record before it, that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment. The Conservancy hereby directs staff to file a Notice of Determination with the State Clearinghouse for this Project.”

Staff further recommends that the Conservancy adopt the following resolution pursuant to Government Code section 66907.7:

“The Conservancy hereby authorizes staff to award a Proposition 1 acquisition grant in the amount up to \$1,200,000 to Placer County for the Griff Creek Corridor and Public Access Project and take all other necessary steps consistent with the accompanying staff recommendation.”
