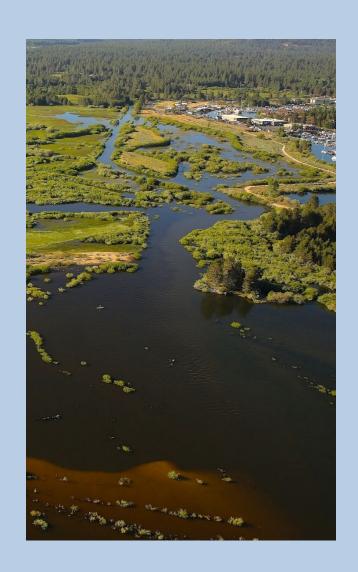
- 1. Conservancy Lands and Wildfire
  - Manage and protect urban lots and open spaces
  - Improve forest health, reduce forest fuels, and remove hazard trees





### 2. Resilient Forests and Watersheds

- Restore Conservancy and partner streams, wetlands, and habitat
- Co-lead landscape-scale, multijurisdictional watershed and forest health projects





### 3. Public Access and Recreation

- Manage Conservancy beaches and open space
- Provide grants for community bike trails, pedestrian trails, and lakeshore improvements





# 4. Climate Adaptation and Livable Communities

- Complete adaptation planning, and provide grants and technical assistance
- Support increased workforce and affordable housing projects on state-owned lands
- Continued land bank operations

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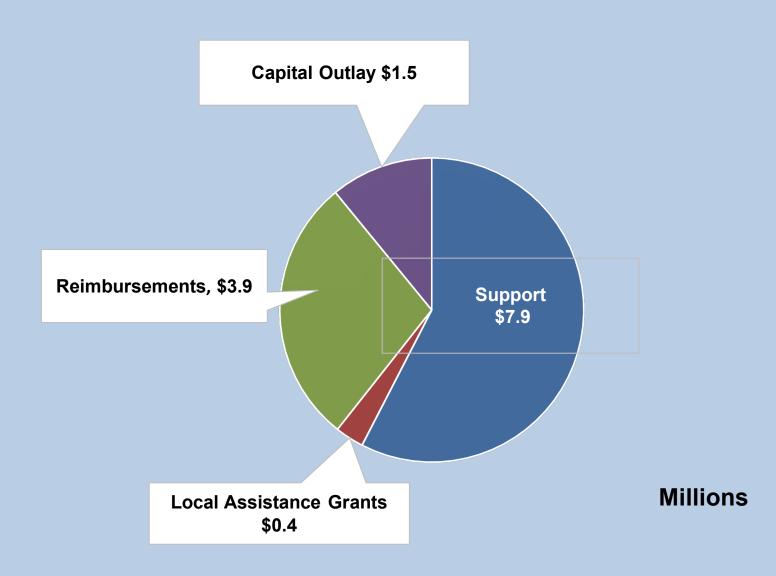
