- Enhance recreational opportunities for Kings Beach community
- Allow for educational and interpretive programming
- Improve accessibility for families and visitors with mobility challenges

Schedule

Execute agreement with DPR	Summer 2020
Conduct surveys	Fall 2020 – Summer 2021
Design and engineering	Summer 2021 – Fall 2022
Apply for permits	Winter 2022 – Spring 2023
Prepare bid package	Winter 2022 – Summer 2023



Recommendation

Staff recommends adoption of Resolution 20-06-05 making necessary CEQA findings and authorizing the award of a grant to the California Department of Parks and Recreation of up to \$650,000 to complete final design and permitting for pier relocation and recreation improvements at Kings Beach State Recreation Area.
