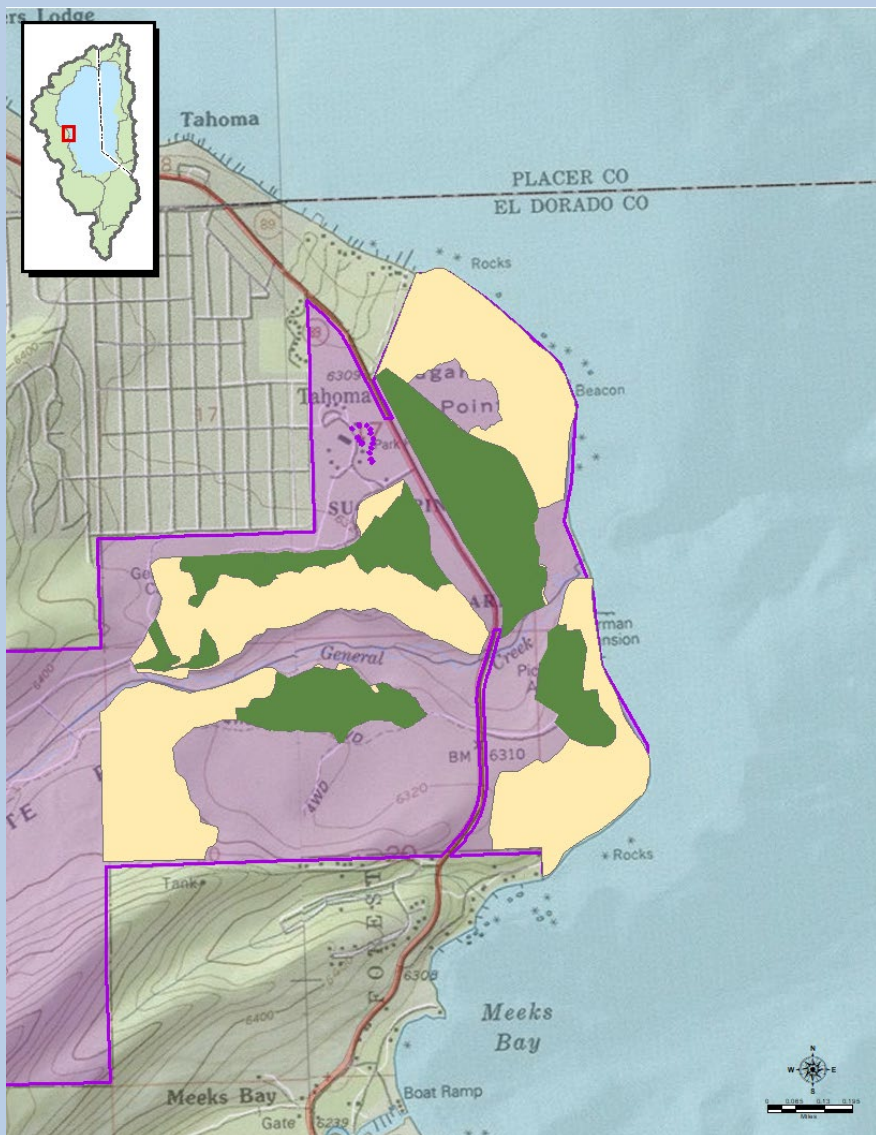

Background

- Conservancy received Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act (SNPLMA) grant in 2016
- Conservancy authorized a grant to Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) for Phase 1 of the Project in 2017 (104 acres)
- Conservancy authorized a grant to DPR for Phase 2 of the Project in 2019 (150 acres)

Background



California State Parks Fuel Hazard Reduction and Understory Burning Project

- 104 acres completed through Phase 1
- 267 remaining acres within the park in-need of hazardous fuel reduction treatment
- 150 acres authorized through Phase 2



Project Budget

Project	Acres	Amount
Phase 2 of the Project (Previously Authorized in December 2019)	150	\$487,500
Additional Funds (New Authorization)	-	\$97,500
Total	150	\$585,000



Recommendation

Staff recommends adoption of Resolution 20-09-05 authorizing the award of a grant to the California Department of Parks and Recreation for up to \$97,500 for Phase 2 of the California State Parks Fuel Hazard Reduction and Understory Burning Project.
