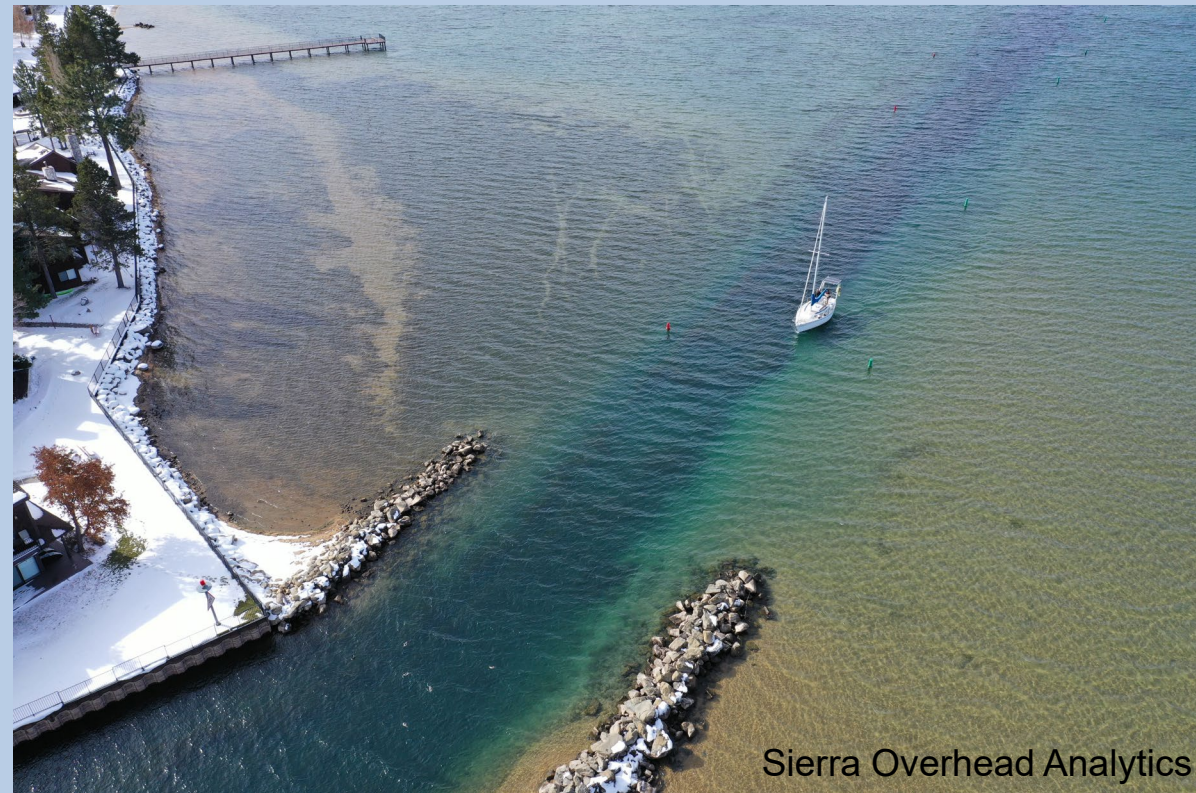
Curly-leaf Pondweed

Recommendation

Staff recommends adoption of Resolution 21-03-04 authorizing staff to award a grant to the Tahoe Resource Conservation District for up to \$500,000 to conduct aquatic invasive plant control activities within the Tahoe Keys Offshore Complex and containing the appropriate California Environmental Quality Act determination.
