# Recommended Actions

## **Authorize two (2) Senate Bill 630 Access Grants**

1. North Tahoe Public Utility District – Tahoe Vista Recreation Area Facility Improvements (\$130,800)
2. Tahoe City Public Utility District – Lake Forest Boat Ramp Restroom Replacement (\$75,000)

# Background – Senate Bill 630



## The Lake Tahoe Science and Lake Improvement Account

Dedicated revenue supporting:

- Tahoe Science Advisory Council (CNRA)
- Nearshore Research and Monitoring (Lahontan)
- Aquatic Invasive Species Control and Lake Access Improvement (Conservancy)

# Background – Tahoe Vista Recreation Area

- Year-round lake access  
*Swimming, fishing, kayaking,  
and paddleboarding*
- Previous site improvements  
*Restrooms, bike racks,  
parking, stormwater treatment*

***Scenic overlook, access trail,  
and picnic area are dilapidated  
and eroded***



# Grant Award – Tahoe Vista Recreation Area



## Grant funding will:

- Repair the scenic overlook
- Construct an ADA compliant path
- Install benches, picnic tables, and interpretive signage
- Purchase and install new lockable kayak and paddleboard racks

# Grant Award – Tahoe Vista Recreation Area

## Anticipated Activities:

- Pavers and curbing (path and overlook)
- Kayak/paddleboard Racks
- Benches, picnic tables, and interpretive signage

*This grant leverages \$214,200 from Placer County's Tourism Master Plan program and nearly \$200,000 of NTPUD in-kind project support.*

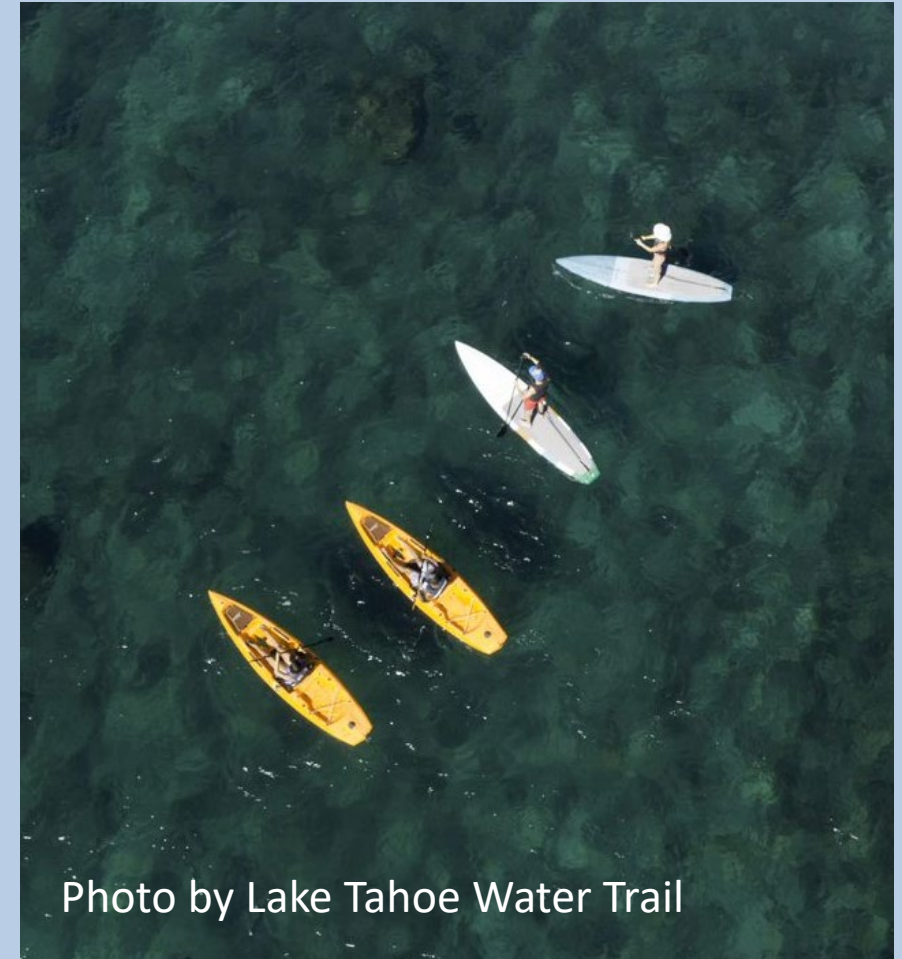

# Background – Lake Forest Boat Ramp

- Popular public lake access facility managed by TCPUD
- Site amenities include:  
*Athletic field, playground, picnic area, pier, boat ramp.*

***NTPUD last renovated the existing restroom in the early 1990s***



# Grant Award – Lake Forest Boat Ramp



## Grant funding will:

- Provide \$75,000 to help purchase a new prefabricated restroom (ADA compliant, year-round facility)

***This grant leverages \$178,000 in California DPR funding and \$262,000 in TCPUD project funding***





# Next Steps

- **Draft scope of work and budget**
- **Execute grant agreement**
- **Construct project improvements**



# Recommendation

Staff recommends adoption of Resolution 22-03-04.1 authorizing:



A grant to the North Tahoe Public Utility District for up to \$130,800 for public facility improvements at the Tahoe Vista Recreation Area.

# Recommendation

Staff recommends adoption of Resolution 22-03-04.2 authorizing:

A grant to the Tahoe City Public Utility District for up to \$75,000 to replace a restroom at the Lake Forest Boat Ramp.
