PIONEER TRAIL/U.S. HIGHWAY 50 INTERSECTION SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT SHORT TERM LICENSE AGREEMENT AND PERMANENT EASEMENTS

Staff recommends that the California Tahoe Conservancy (Conservancy) make the following findings based on the accompanying staff report pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.:

"The Conservancy, in its role as a responsible agency under the California Environmental Quality Act, has reviewed and considered the Pioneer Trail/US Highway 50 Intersection Safety Improvement Project (Project) Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) adopted by El Dorado County (County) on January 4, 2022.

The Conservancy finds, on the basis of the whole record before it, that there is no substantial evidence that the Project as mitigated will have a significant effect on the environment. The Conservancy adopts the County's Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan as set forth in the IS/MND and incorporates compliance as a condition for approval of the Project. The Conservancy hereby directs staff to file a Notice of Determination with the State Clearinghouse for this Project."

Staff further recommends that the Conservancy adopt the following resolution pursuant to Government Code sections 66907.8 and 66907.9:

"The Conservancy hereby authorizes staff to take all actions necessary or appropriate to negotiate, execute, and convey to the County a short-term license agreement on El Dorado County Assessment Numbers (ANs) 034-270-041, 034-270-055, and 034-270-056, and two permanent easements on ANs 034-270-041 and 034-270-055, to facilitate the Project consistent with the accompanying staff recommendation."
