#### Recommendation



Staff recommends adoption of Resolution 23-06-04 containing the appropriate California Environmental Quality Act determination and authorizing: (1) a grant to the City of South Lake Tahoe for up to \$1,000,000 in additional funding to construct the Tahoe Valley Stormwater and Greenbelt Improvement Project; and (2) an amendment to the existing long-term license agreement to add the Conservancy's Urgent Care parcel and to reflect changes to the Project on the Conservancy's Smoke Shop parcel.
