TRAILHEAD RELOCATION GRANT

Staff recommends that the California Tahoe Conservancy (Conservancy) make the following findings based on the accompanying staff report pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.:

“The Conservancy, in its role as a responsible agency under the California Environmental Quality Act, previously reviewed and considered the Tahoe Cross-Country Lodge Replacement and Expansion Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR), which was certified by the Tahoe City Public Utility District (TCPUD) on February 25, 2021. The Conservancy has further considered the Addendum filed by the TCPUD on October 15, 2024.

The Conservancy finds and determines that the potential environmental effects of the Tahoe Cross-Country Lodge Replacement and Expansion Project, Phase 1 (Project) are within the scope of the EIR and Addendum, and no new or substantially increased environmental impacts that were not previously analyzed would occur as a result of the Project; therefore, no further environmental review is required. The Board further finds that it can rely on the CEQA Findings previously adopted by the Board in Resolution 22-06-04. The Conservancy hereby directs staff to file a Notice of Determination with the State Clearinghouse.”

Staff further recommends that the Conservancy adopt the following resolution pursuant to Government Code section 66907.7:

“The Conservancy hereby authorizes staff to award an implementation grant to the Tahoe Cross-Country Ski Education Association for up to \$125,000 of Proposition 68 funding to construct the Project, and to take all other necessary steps consistent with the accompanying staff recommendation.”
