Project Location:

In Tahoe City on Tahoe City Public Utility District (TCPUD) property (Placer County Assessment Number 093-160-064) off Polaris Road and adjacent to the North Tahoe High School, in Placer County (Exhibit A).

Project Description:

The Conservancy will provide a \$125,000 grant to the Tahoe Cross-Country Ski Education Association to construct Phase 1 of the Tahoe Cross-Country Lodge Replacement and Expansion Project. Phase 1 includes a parking lot, sidewalk, and stormwater improvements, and will immediately serve as a new public trailhead.

This is to advise that the California Tahoe Conservancy (Conservancy), acting as a responsible agency, has approved the above described project on September 18, 2025 (Agenda Item 11) and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. The Conservancy previously considered the Tahoe Cross-Country Lodge Replacement and Expansion Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR) prepared by the lead agency, the TCPUD (see Resolution 22-06-04, adopted June 16, 2022). On October 15, 2024, the TCPUD filed an Addendum to the EIR. The Conservancy considered the Addendum together with the EIR prior to the approval of the above described project.
3. Mitigation measures are a condition of the approval of the project by the TCPUD and the Conservancy.
4. The Conservancy previously adopted the TCPUD's mitigation monitoring and reporting program.
5. The Conservancy previously adopted findings pursuant to section 15091 of the CEQA Guidelines.
6. The Conservancy did not adopt a Statement of Overriding Considerations.
