VAN SICKLE BI-STATE PARK SAFETY AND EQUITABLE ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The staff recommends that the California Tahoe Conservancy (Conservancy) adopt the following resolution based on the accompanying staff report, and pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.:

“The Conservancy, in its capacity as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), prepared a Supplemental Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) to evaluate the Van Sickle Bi-State Park Safety and Equitable Access Improvements Project (Van Sickle Project). The Conservancy finds on the basis of the whole record before it that there is no substantial evidence that the Van Sickle Project, as mitigated, will have a significant effect on the environment, and that the Supplemental IS/MND reflects the Conservancy’s independent judgment and analysis. The Conservancy hereby adopts the Supplemental IS/MND.

Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, section 15074(d), the Conservancy adopts the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (Exhibit A), which incorporates mitigation measures and ensures that the required mitigation is implemented for the Project.

The Conservancy directs the staff to file a Notice of Determination for this Project with the State Clearinghouse.”

The staff also recommends that the Conservancy adopt the following resolution pursuant to Government Code sections 66906.8, 66907, 66907.9, 66907.10, and 66908:

“The Conservancy hereby approves the Van Sickle Project, including authorizing the staff to accept and expend up to a combined \$10 million to implement the project together with the Dennis T. Machida Memorial Greenway – Van Sickle Connector, and to enter into agreements and take

all other necessary steps consistent with the accompanying staff recommendation to implement the Van Sickle Project.”
